PURPOSE

To establish guidelines in using the Life Star Medical Transportation System.

POLICY

Life Star Medical Transport can be a highly effective means of transporting critically injured persons to area hospitals. The department will utilize the system under the following guidelines.

Procedures

- A. In most cases it would be counter-productive to use Life Star due the closeness of Hamden to New Haven. The following should be considered:
 - 1. The amount of time it will take to transport a victim by ground to area facilities.
 - 2. Weather, road or traffic problems that might affect patients transport.
 - 3. If a patient cannot be extradited and Advanced Life Support cannot be accomplished by local services.
 - 4. The final decision to call Life Star will be the Shift Supervisor.
- B. Landing Zone.
 - 1. Must be at least 60 ft. by 60 ft. relatively flat and free of overhead obstruction.
 - 2. Should be well marked with four flares one for each corner.
 - 3. Every attempt should be made to secure any hazardous debris.
 - 4. The pilot should be advised of any problems in the landing area.

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- a. Communications has a radio frequency to communicate with the pilot.
- C. Safety Rules.
 - 1. Keep well clear of landing zone on approach and take off.
 - 2. Do not aim lights at the aircraft at any time.
 - 3. Once on the ground no one should enter the landing zone until instructed to do so by the pilot or flight nurse.
 - 4. Establish ground security around aircraft and at no time allow anyone near the rear rotor.
