PURPOSE

Members of the Hamden Police Department, reporting or being assigned to fire scenes, will adhere to the procedures set forth in this General Order.

Procedures

- A. Duties of Officers Reporting Fires or Assigned to Fire Scenes.
 - 1. Assess the situation and advise Headquarters if any additional assistance is needed.
 - 2. Attempt to evacuate any individuals in the structure involved, if necessary.
 - 3. Provide first aid and request additional medical assistance, if needed.
 - 4. Upon arrival of Fire Department personnel:
 - a. Isolate the area and prevent all non-essential pedestrian or vehicle access.
 - b. Provide traffic control.
 - c. Assist in evacuating occupants of surrounding buildings, if necessary
- B. Fires of Suspicious Origin and Fires Resulting in Death or Serious Injury.
 - In the event the Fire Department determines a fire to be of suspicious origin or the fire results in the loss of life or serious injury, the Patrol Supervisor will be notified.
 - 2. Duties of Patrol Supervisor .a. Assess the situation and if circumstances warrant
 - a. Arrange for the scene to be photographed
 - b. Notify the Detective Division.
