Title: Building Access / Visitors Approval Date: November 14 2012

Purpose:

To establish procedures for entry and movement into the Hamden Police Department Facility by non-employees.

Policy:

The Hamden Police Department must restrict entry and access of individuals to ensure a safe work environment.

Procedures:

- A. Building access by non-employees:
 - I. A visitor's pass will be issued to individuals entering the facility by the Headquarters supervisor upon proper Identification. A log will note the arrival and departure of the individual.
 - 2. Visitors shall be met by an employee in the lobby and escorted to their destination.
 - When the purpose of visit has been completed an employee will escort them back to the lobby and the visitors pass will be turned in.
 - 3. Complainants or Witnesses will not be left unmonitored in any Interview Room.
- B. Building access for law enforcement personnel from an outside agency;
 - I. A visitor's pass will be issued to law enforcement personnel from an outside agency entering the facility through the front lobby.
 - 2. An employee of the Hamden Police Department should escort these personnel to their destination. At the discretion of the desk supervisor these personnel may be directed to their destination unescorted.

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- a. These personnel do not have to surrender their weapons upon entry into the facility; their weapons must be surrendered upon entering detention area.
- D. Building access for Town employees.
 - 1. Town employees who conduct regular business inside the facility will be issued a visitors pass. At the discretion of the desk supervisor these individuals may enter and conduct business within the facility unescorted by an employee of the Hamden Police Department. Examples;
 - a. Town plumber
 - b. Town electrician
 - c. Town supervisor of buildings
 - 2. The following persons who have regular business inside of the facility will be issued a visitors pass. These individuals will be escorted within the facility.

Examples:

- a. Vending machine employees
- b. Office supply employees
- c. Fed Ex and UPS employees

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
